MAD SUMMER SPECIAL IN AUGRABIES FALLS NATIONAL PARK AND KGALAGADI TRANSFRONTIER NATIONAL PARK

Travellers are invited to take advantage of this wonderful offer to visit two of South Africa's spectacular desert parks in the aftermath of the end of year holiday season, but before the busy Easter holiday season.

First there is the Augrabies Falls National Park with its breath-taking landmarks, such as Moon Rock, Ararat and Echo Corner and where the might of the Orange River cascades down a rocky abyss. Here visitors can indulge in adventure activities such as river rafting, mountain biking and hiking.
